An occasional commentator on FOX Business, ABC News, and NPR, Sean earned both a bachelor's degree and master's degree in economics at the University of Southern California. Sean went on to earn his Ph.D. in economics from UC Berkeley where he completed his dissertation under the supervision of Nobel Laureate George Akerlof. #### PRESIDENT'S MESSAGE —-President Dale Dieleman—

#### FREE MARKET HEALTH CARE

Our next dinner speaker, Sean Flynn, will be speaking to us concerning national healthcare and, in particular, national healthcare costs. He uses several examples but the one which stands out is Singapore. In Singapore everyone is required to purchase healthcare but are free to shop for the best rates. This is similar to mandatory car insurance. We must have car insurance but we are free to shop for the lowest rates thus creating competition between insurance companies.

Singapore has healthcare coverage which is said to be as good or better than what we have in the United States at a cost of just under 5% of their gross national product while we are spending approximately 18% of our gross national product on healthcare. Despite the promise that Obama Care would bring the cost of healthcare down, it has risen.

So why don't we just copy the national healthcare plan of Singapore? It is important to point out that in the United States our federal government has no constitutional authority to be involved in healthcare; however, there is nothing to stop any state from implementing their own healthcare system.

The beauty of implementing healthcare on the state level is that by doing so each state's plan can be compared to the others. For example, let's say California implements a single payer plan, which they are talking about doing, while Kentucky implements a free market plan similar to Singapore. The cost of the two plans can be compared.

According to the Centers for Medicare & Medicaid Services, "U.S. healthcare spending is projected to grow by an average 5.6% annually over the next decade," This is unsustainable and unnecessary. There is a better way as Singapore has shown us by their free market system.

#### 9/11 DO NOT FORGET

Where were you and what were you doing at 8:45 a.m. on September 11, 2001? With the world as it is today, one may need reminded of the 9/11 tragedy.

On September 11, 2001, 19 militants associated with the Islamic extremist group al-Qaeda hijacked four airplanes and carried out suicide attacks against targets in the United States. Almost 3,000 people were killed during the 9/11 terrorist attacks, which triggered major U.S. initiatives to combat terrorism and defined the presidency of George W. Bush.

At 8:45 a.m. on a clear Tuesday morning, an American Airlines Boeing 767 loaded with 20,000 gallons of jet fuel crashed into the north tower of the World Trade Center.

As the evacuation of the tower and its twin got underway, television cameras broadcasted live images of what initially appeared to be a freak accident. Then, 18 minutes after the first plane hit, a second appeared out of the sky and sliced into the south tower. The U.S. was under attack.

As millions watched the events unfolding in New York, American Airlines Flight 77 circled over downtown Washington, DC before crashing into the west side of the Pentagon military headquarters at 9:45 a.m. Jet fuel from the Boeing 757 caused a devastating inferno that led to the structural collapse of a portion of the giant concrete building, headquarters of the Department of Defense.

A fourth California-bound plane was hijacked about 40 minutes after leaving an airport in New Jersey. Because the plane had been delayed, passengers on board learned of events in New York and Washington via cell phone and airfone calls to the ground. Knowing that the aircraft was not returning to an airport as the hijackers claimed, a group of passengers and flight attendants planned an insurrection.

They fought the four hijackers and are suspected to have attached the cockpit with a fire extinguisher. The plane then flipped and sped toward the ground at upwards of 500 miles per hour crashing in a rural field killing 44 passengers.

Some of the terrorists had lived in the U.S. for more than a year and had taken flying lessons at American commercial flight schools. Others had slipped into the country in the months prior to September 11.
