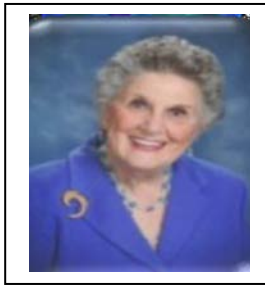

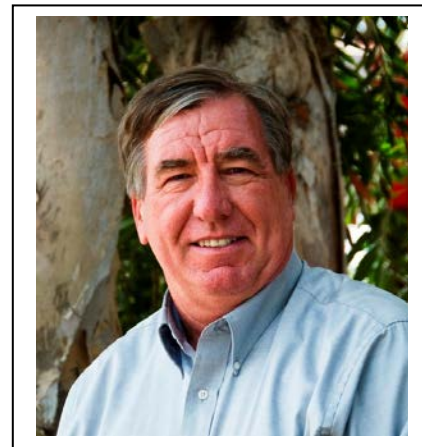
## **President's Message Barbara Fleeman Hazlett January 2018**

## ***Keynote Speaker* Oceanside City Councilman Jerry Kern 2018 Candidate for 5<sup>th</sup> District San Diego County Supervisor**

Jerry Kern was first elected to the Oceanside city council in 2006, and was re-elected to his third term in November 2014.

After serving in the United States Air Force in England and at Marine Corps Base Camp Pendleton Jerry and his wife Blake decided to make Oceanside their home, raise their two children, and have resided there for the past 41 years. Jerry received his Bachelor of Science degree in Business Administration from San Diego State University, and Social Science and Business teaching credential from Chapman University.

Jerry and his wife were co-founders of Pacific View Charter School, the first charter school to be approved in Oceanside, where they also taught for many years. He is a retired High School teacher.

Jerry has been very involved in his community over the past 41 years. He has served as President of the Oceanside Chamber of Commerce, along with numerous local boards, committees, and commissions. In addition, Jerry has served on several regional boards including the San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and the San Diego County Water Authority. Currently Jerry serves on the Community Engagement panel for the decommissioning of the San Onofre Nuclear Generating Station (SONGS). He is currently a candidate for the San Diego County 5<sup>th</sup> District Supervisor position.
