#### President's Message Barbara Fleeman Hazlett

Only 85 days left before The November elections. We have been working hard since the Primary in June to inform voters about the Republican Candidates that must be elected to make California the Golden State it once was: John Cox for Governor, Judge Steven Bailey for Attorney General, and Mark Meuser for Secretary of State. In Congressional District 49, there is a concentrated effort to elect Diane Harkey to replace retiring Congressman Darrell Issa.

There will be a Victory Strategy Session held on Saturday, August 18, from 1:00 PM to 3:00 PM at Ocean Hills Country Club to train residents to contact registered voters to get out and vote in November for our endorsed candidates. We will need the cooperation of all the members to succeed.

In California we will have Prop. 6-Repeal the Gas Tax on the November ballot. This is important to all Californians, Republican, Democrat and Independent. The gas taxes in California are already the second highest in the country. The tax money raised in the past has not been used to improve our highways and infrastructure. It has been diverted to The General Fund. Even to The Bullet Train to Nowhere. In addition, this Gas Tax Law allows for an automatic tax increase every year. We have "Prop.6-Stop the Gas Tax" signs available for your front lawn now, for display after Labor Day. This is not a partisan issue. Every house should have a sign.

The City of Oceanside will have two Initiatives on the ballot November 6<sup>th</sup>; Approval of a ½% sales tax, which we oppose and approval of S.O.A.R, which we also oppose. S.O.A.R., (Save Our Agricultural Resources) takes away the property rights of the farmers. It forces them to have their property changes, not only approved by the Oceanside City Council, but approved by the total vote of registered Oceanside residents. The farmer would have to pay the cost of putting his request on the ballot. It could cost from \$50,000 to \$500,000. It is an unjust restriction. We must become involved and energized to save our beautiful city and state.
