The first big event for the Republican Club of Ocean Hills of 2019 was a big success! On Sunday, February 17th, more than 80 Republicans and friends gathered in Abravenal Hall at Ocean Hills Country Club for a presentation by Ninia Hammond of Integral Communities. She spoke about their proposed North River Farms project for South Morro Hills. The planned community will have four levels of homes starting with 1700 square feet, at an accessible price for first-time buyers. There will be parks, bike and hiking trails, and a Village Square. It will include a farmers market, concert venue, and maker spaces for artists and craftsmen. These amenities will be open to the public. The road and infrastructure improvement will benefit the City as a whole and the concept would increase the tax base and public perception of the City of Oceanside. This is possible because we succeeded in defeating the S.O.A. R. Initiative that would have prevented development of previously designated farm land without the vote of the all Oceanside voters. Our next step is to attend the Oceanside City Council meeting on Wednesday, March 13, 2019, at 6:00 P.M. to voice our support. Let your voice be heard. The City of Oceanside Council Chambers is at 300 N. Coast Highway, Oceanside. Plan now on participating. Even transportation will be provided.

At the February 11, 2019 San Diego County Republican Party meeting Chairman Tony Krvaric gave us a blue print for rebuilding the Republican Party in San Diego County. It will start with a Captain in every precinct. It will not be knocking on doors at election time. Basically, we will ask precinct Captains to build a year-long relationship with low-propensity Republican voters. They will do this in their precincts with monthly "touches" be it a flyer, phone call or email. So by the time election rolls around, they will have communicated with each voter at least 12 times. Those contacts will include offering to be a resource for voting tips and actual voting, including collecting their ballots, if that is what they want. With those initiatives we will turn San Diego County RED again.
