Mr. Desmond was recently elected as San Diego County Supervisor of District 5 which includes the cities of Oceanside, Carlsbad, Vista, San Marco and Fallbrook. Jim was elected Mayor of San Marcos in 2006 and re-elected in 2010 and 2014. For two years prior to being elected mayor, Desmond served as a San Marcos City Council member. In addition to mayoral duties, he was the City's primary representative as Board Member of San Diego Association of Governments (SANDAG) and was the Chairman of the SANDAG Regional Transportation Committee.

Jim also served as Chairman of San Marcos Fire Protection District. Since 2007, he represented the North County Inland Cities (San Marcos, Vista, Escondido, and Poway) as a Board Member of San Diego County Regional Airport Authority. Desmond's city service started in 2000 as president of the board of San Marcos Economic Development Corporation (SMEDC) and from 2002 as an alternate on the city Planning Commission.

Supervisor Desmond is a US Navy veteran. He earned a Bachelor Degree in Electrical Engineering from San Diego State University and completed the Leadership North County program at California State University San Marcos. In the 1990s he founded, managed, and sold Technical Standards, Inc. a technical writing and document company. Desmond served as a San Marcos Chamber of Commerce board member.

Since 1986, Jim Desmond is currently employed as a Captain for Delta Air Lines flying Boeing 757s and 767s domestically and internationally.

Supervisor Desmond and his wife of 33 years, Kerri, reside in San Marcos. They have two grown children.
